## ARMY DISASTER PERSONNEL ACCOUNTABILITY & ASSESSMENT SYSTEM (ADPAAS)

The Army Disaster Personnel Accountability and Assessment System (ADPASS) is a website designed to assist Army personnel and their Families when they have been directly affected by a natural or manmade disaster. Through ADPAAS,

all Department of the Army (DA) personnel and their Families can report their current location, update any emergency contact information and request assistance.

If you are displaced, you can use public computers at places like shelters, schools, libraries, suggested community centers, or at local relief organizations. If you do not have access to a computer, anyone with computer access can use ADPAAS on your behalf.

A disaster, whether manmade or natural, can severely impact everyone affected, your property and environment. It can generate an overwhelming emotional and physical disruption of the normal day-to-day functions.

When you are affected by a disaster, log onto ADPAAS and validate your current location. Once your location has been verified, if you are in need of assistance you would then complete the needs assessment.



Through the ADPAAS needs assessment you can connect with the resources necessary to meet the challenges brought on by the disaster. Once you complete a needs assessment you will be contacted by a service provider from the Army who will assist you. All components of the Army are utilized to provide the outreach closest to wherever you are located. Assistance can also be coordinated through other military services depending on your location.

The service provider will contact you via telephone or email based on the information you provide in ADPAAS. They can provide you with information about available local organizations and services as well as any military programs available in the area, link you to appropriate services, provide relevant forms you may need, make referrals for you, keep you updated on the status of the disaster. Your service provider will continue to work with you and your Family until all issues are resolved.
